Below you will find a list of candidates that have been slated by the Nominating Committee and their biographical information.

Pursuant to Article VI, Section 1 of the FPFCU Bylaws:

- ...nominations for vacancies may also be made by petition signed by one percent of the members with a minimum of 20 and a maximum of 500 (at least 40 signatures would be required to comply).

Such petitions must be received by the Chairman of the Board of Financial Partners Federal Credit Union no later than **April 4, 2026**. Any such nominee shall be required to provide a written statement of qualifications, biographical data and signed certificate that they are agreeable to the nomination and that they will serve if elected to office.
